to attend due to doctor's appointments. Judy Leonard brought her friend, Karen, who was visiting from Massachusetts.

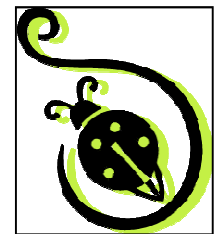
